ADMISSION INFORMATION AT A GLANCE

For All Undergraduate Programs - Fall 2010 Trimester

Applicants seeking admission in **Undergraduate Programs** of Stamford University, Bangladesh should remember the following information:

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION:

- To apply for admission minimum required GPA is 2.5 both in S.S.C./equivalent and H.S.C./equivalent.
- Minimum 3 subjects in O-Level and 2 subjects in A-Level with a minimum grade of C.
- Applicants who have passed their S.S.C. within 2005 are eligible to apply. Applicants who have passed S.S.C. before 2005 are not eligible to apply.
- Applicants of Engineering programs must have mathematics in H.S.C. level.
- Applicants of Pharmacy program must have biology and mathematics in H.S.C. level.

ADMISSION TEST:

Applicant has to be qualified in **Admission Test** which includes **written exam as well as viva voce**.

DIRECT ADMISSION:

Students who have fulfilled the following criteria will have to face a viva voce to get themselves admitted directly:

For BBA, Pharmacy & EEE : Total GPA **7.50** or above (Adding the GPA of SSC & HSC)

For Others Program : Total GPA **7.00** or above (Adding the GPA of SSC & HSC)

Note: All directly admitted students would have to attend the **Placement Test** on English**.
Students seeking scholarship on the basis of performance in admission test can sit for written test.

**** English section (Section-A) of Written Test of relevant program usually considered as Placement Test.**

FOUNDATION COURSE:

Foundation course of English is mandatory for those who will not be able to secure above 50% marks in English section of Admission test / Placement test.

NECESSARY PAPERS & PHOTOGRAPHS TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF FORM SUBMISSION:

1. **Attested** photocopies of S.S.C. or equivalent Marks sheet and Certificate or Testimonial
2. **Attested** photocopies of H.S.C. or equivalent Marks sheet and Certificate or Testimonial
3. 02 (two) copies of **attested** pp size recent color photographs

NECESSARY PAPERS & PHOTOGRAPHS TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION:

1. **Original** Marks sheet & Certificate or Testimonial of both S.S.C and H.S.C or equivalent must be shown at the time of admission
2. 02 (two) copies of pp size attested & 03 (three) copies of stamp size color photographs
3. Student must be present physically at the time of admission

Note: Failure to submit any of the documents or photographs along with the "Application Form" stated above will be considered / treated as incomplete form which may result in cancellation of the application form / admission.

ORIENTATION PROGRAM:

Freshman Orientation would be held at the beginning of a trimester and all the newly admitted students should have to attend the orientation program.

TUITION FEE PAYMENT POLICY:

100% course fee of a trimester is to be paid at the time of course registration i.e. before the enrollment of a trimester.

SCHOLARSHIP:

Scholarship will be awarded to the students on the basis of merit list in Written Test for the first trimester only and on the basis of merit list of Trimester Final exam result from the second trimester and onwards (excluding last trimester).
