Publication Policy & Author's Guidelines

The formatting of all articles/papers selected for publication must conform to the following guidelines:

1. The paper/article must be based on original research and be unpublished and must not be submitted in whole or in part elsewhere, and should demonstrate the author's own analysis. All papers/articles will undergo the peer review process and will handle all submissions according to generally accepted standard.
2. The final copy of the manuscript should be submitted through CD/in PDF/RTF/E-mail neatly typed in 2.0" space on one side of A4 size paper having margins 1.25" on left and 1.0" on right, bottom and top. Font name: Times New Roman, and size: 12.
3. Each paper/article should include an abstract not exceeding 200 words. Keywords of the paper should be specified below the abstract.
4. Illustrations should be included in the typed script. Captions for illustrations should also be at the bottom of the same and should render the illustration intelligible.
5. Table should be kept to a minimum; data should not be presented in both graphical and tabular form, essential tables should be provided with headings and should be intelligible.
6. Bibliographical Referencing (in an alphabetic ascending order) should be made as per following guidelines:
 - *In case of an article*, the citation should be as follows:
Author's last name, first name, and middle initial, year of publication, "Title of the article", Name of the Journal (to be underlined/italicized), ISSN/ISBN, Volume number (month): and Page number (pp).

- *In case of Text Book*, the citation should be as follows:
Author's last name, first name, and middle initial, year of publication, "Title of the book", ISSN/ISBN, Name of the Publisher, Year, and Page number (pp) and/or Chapter No.
- *For citation of published paper/books in text*, it should be, for example, as follows:
 - a) Nilson (2003)
 - b) (Collins and Salatka 1993:122)
 - c) (e.g: see Camerer and Weigelt 1998; Kagel and Roth 1995)
- *In case of online (website) periodicals*, the citation should be, for example, as follows:
Author, A. A. Author, B. B. & Author, C. C. (2000), "Title of article", Title of Periodical, retrieved month, day, year, from source (http ://.....)

7. The manuscript should contain:

- Page 1 (cover page) - Title, Name(s) and Designation of the Author(s), and institutional affiliation(s), complete postal address with phone, fax and e-mail.
- Page 2 – Title, and Abstract, keywords, and paper starts.....

8. The copyright of the paper/article will be reserved by the Stamford University Bangladesh once it is accepted for publication in the journal.

9. More than one paper/article of an author (or as co-author) may not be published in the same issue of the journal.

10. An 'Acceptance Letter' may be issued after receiving comments from the reviewer(s).
